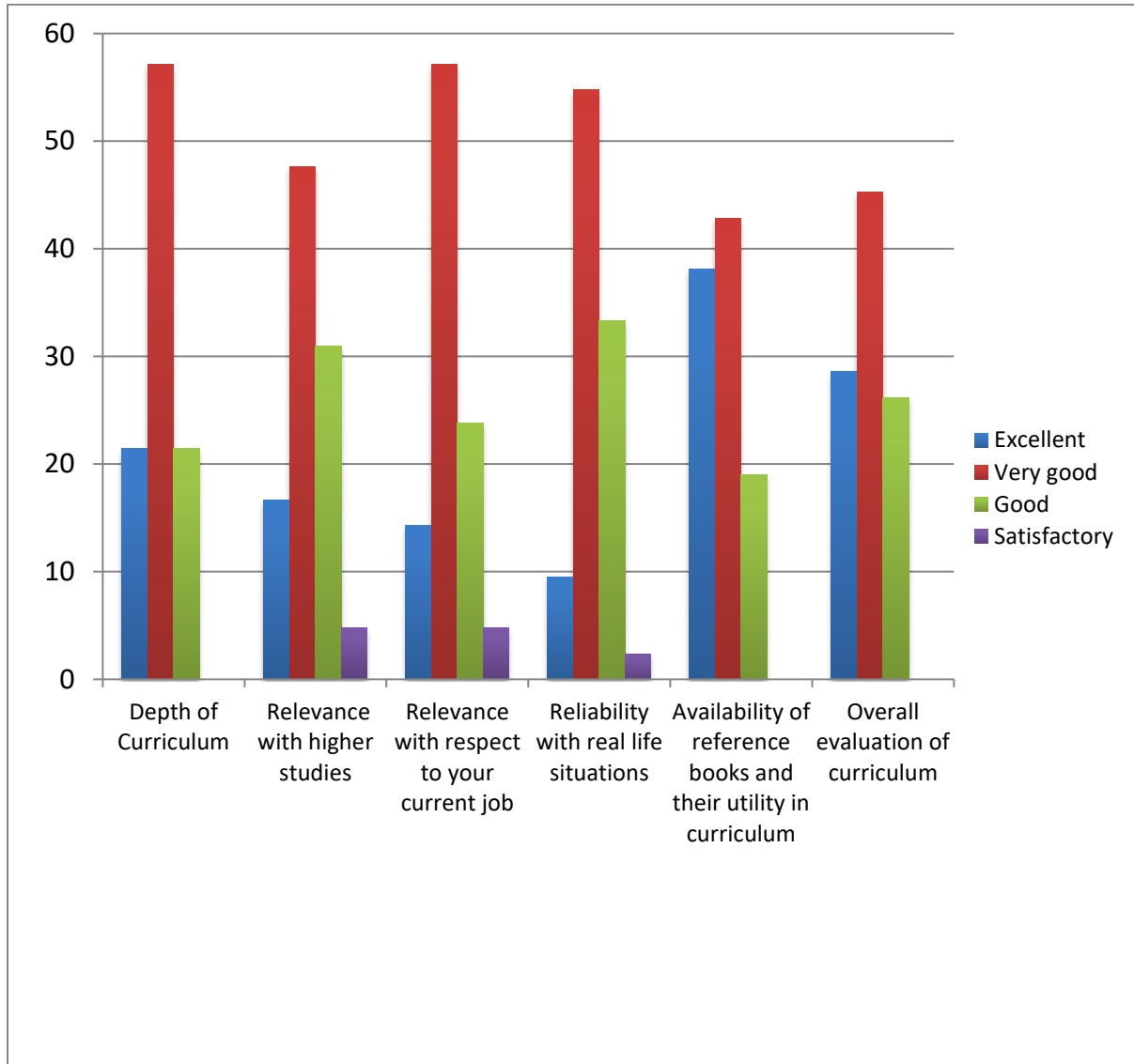

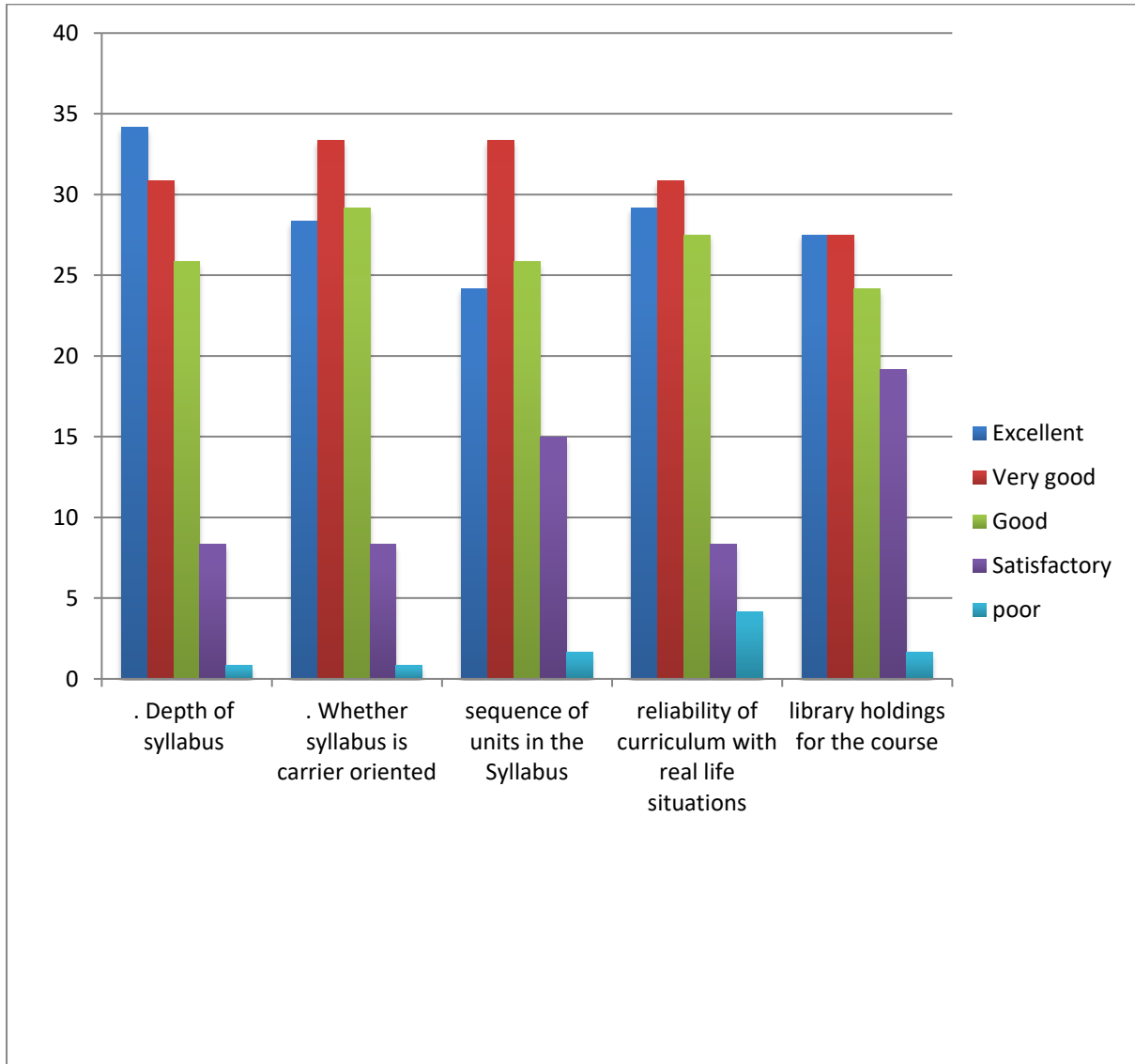

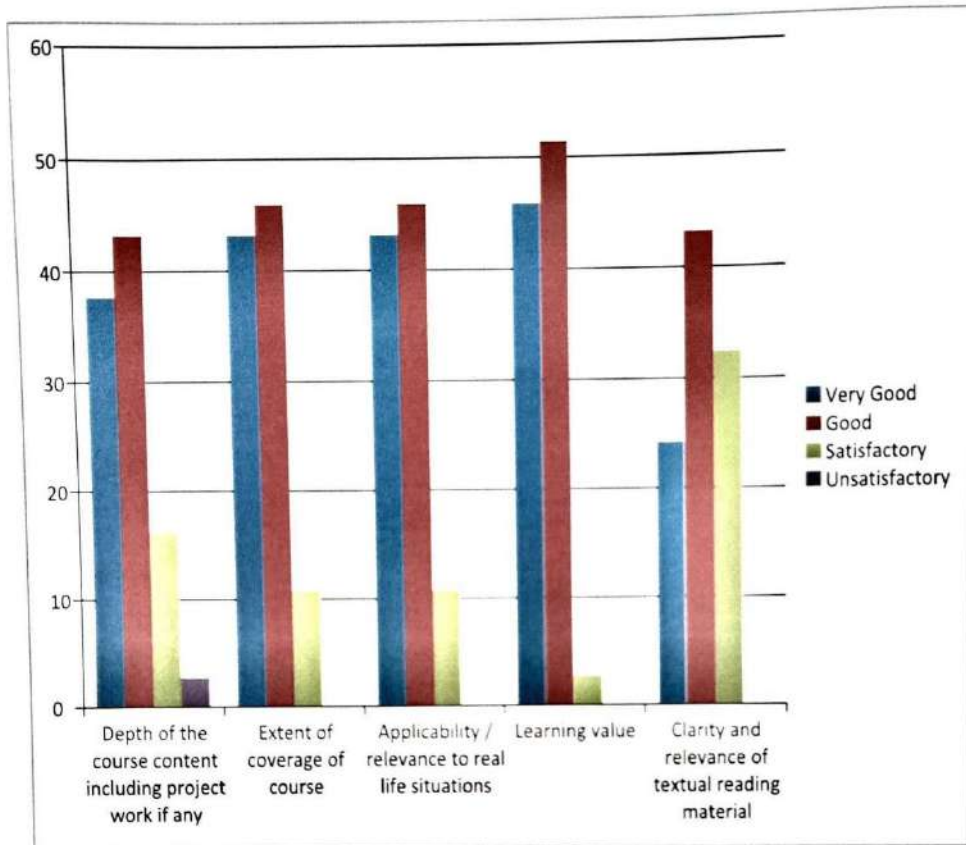

## **Analysis of feedback**
